As discussed at the previous two band booster meetings, in band class, and at the 9th grade parent meeting, we are implementing a Classroom Band Fair Share Assessment of \$60.50 for the 2008/2009 school year. The Classroom Band Fair Share Assessment will be used to supplement money provided by HSHS to enhance the classroom musical experience for every band student. This assessment will be used to fund new band instruments, to purchase new music, to pay Festival dues, and to reimburse visiting clinicians who instruct our students. This assessment is in addition to any GHR marching band fair share payments.
